

Lawn Tractor important information:

Shouldn't need choke to start unless it's been cold soaked for ages.

If it's been sitting for a while over the winter the battery might not have enough juice left in it to start the mower. Pressing on with a discharged battery will only flood it and eventually lead to a hydraulic lock as the motor is new and tight. If you need to jump start it the battery terminals are 'conveniently' located inside the rear right wheel arch!

As with most tractors of this design you shouldn't change gear on the move, it wrecks the gearbox. It will pull away in any gear, it just goes faster the higher the gear - obvious. The clutch is quite fierce and the guys at Husqvarna said to start off in low revs rather than drop the clutch at full throttle as it gives you a smoother take up.

Any issues with it please let Pete, Ken or me know ASAP and we can get it sorted as there are spare keys, battery, oil etc. for it on hand and anything else can be had quickly.
